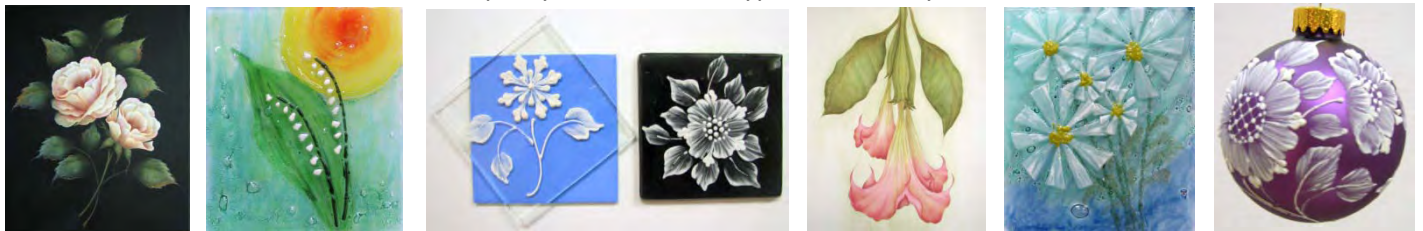

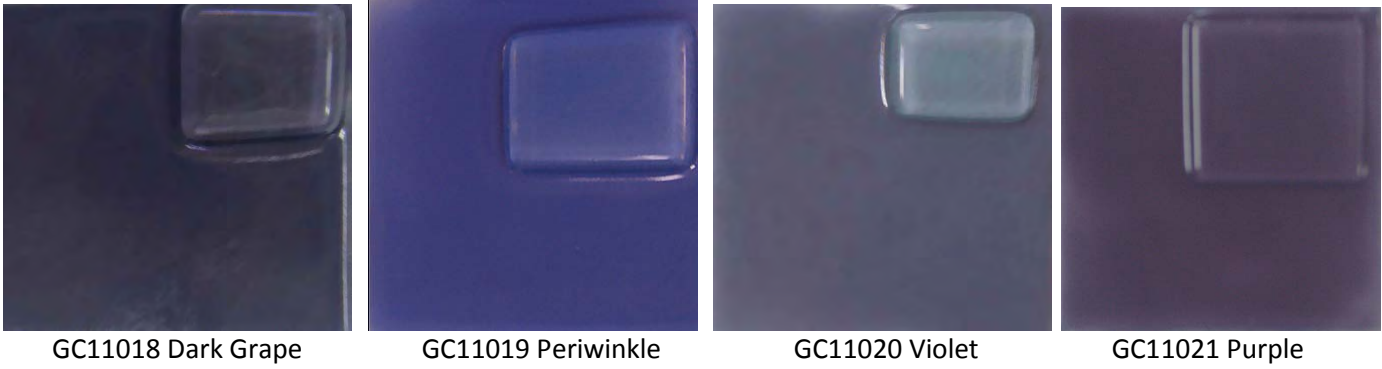

New colors added to the NT color line. Purples! GC11018 Dark Grape – a perfect complement to our existing GC11001 Grape, GC11019 Periwinkle – blue leaning towards purple, GC11020 Violet – soft purple, GC11021 Purple – gorgeous purple. Mix these colors with GC1951 Brite White or GC11016 Vanilla to create a huge range of tints and values. Also,

mix Grape and Dark Grape 1:1 for a nice medium value of Grape. The color chips show the fusing qualities of the colors. The small chip on top shows the color fused between layers of glass.



New Product! Blue Chacopaper is great for transferring designs onto opaque glass surfaces as it dissolves with liquid.
