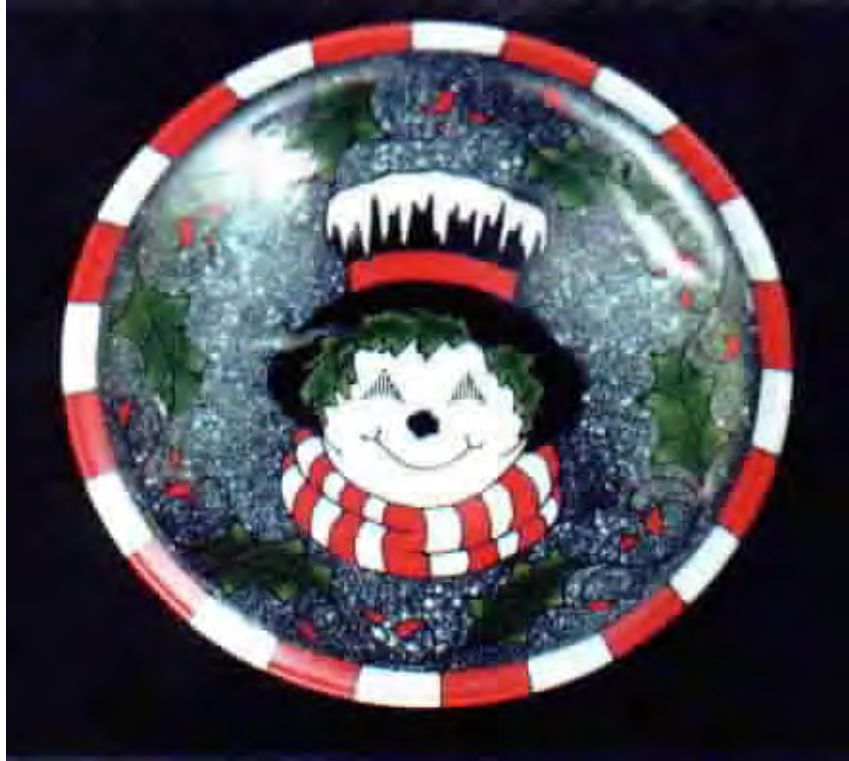


Snow Man and Holly Plate



I have used an 10” plate firing form and double strength float glass for this two project so I could use it as a functional piece, however, the design will easily adapt to many other surfaces. Because the “D” series glass colors contain cadmium and lead I used a drape form so the color would be on the back of the plates and would not come in contact with food.

Palette: All colors are Unique Fired Glass Colors: 971D Deep Red, 972D Lite Red, 1993 Gray, 1995 Apple Green, 1996 Flesh, 1997 Leaf Green, 1961 Dark Green, 1951 Brite White, 1969 Gloss Black, 11003 Brite Pink, Outline Black in Decorator Bottle with metal tip

Supplies: 10/0 short liner brush, toothpicks, “FREE”, piece of white paper larger than the design, cotton swabs, stir stick or palette knife, old toothbrush

Clean glass thoroughly and determine which side is the tinned side and place that side down. Place glass blank over design and outline everything with Outline Black. I begin in the center and work my way out to the edges. If you are using a drape mold you need to sign your name **backwards!** If you are firing flat or using a sagger (strictly for decorative purposes with this design and the reds) then sign as usual. Allow to dry. Remove pattern and set aside for reference. Place glass over white paper to aid you in seeing the edges of the black outline as you place colors on the design.

Apply colors as follows:

Face – Brite White – bring color right up to the lines for the eyes and mouth. White can get on the lines but do not drag the brush across the dried Outline Black.

Evergreen “Hair” – Apply Dark Green in middle section, wiggle Apple Green along top outer edge and Leaf Green along the bottom edge. Do only one leaf at a time.

Hat and Nose – Gloss Black

Band on hat – Deep Red

Icicles on Hat – Brite White

Comma Stroke “Berries” – Refer to pattern for placement of Deep Red and Lite Red

Holly Leaves – Refer to pattern for placement of Dark Green, Apple Green and Leaf Green – wiggle colors into each other in direction of vein lines.

Border – Alternate between Deep Red and Brite White.

Background - Brite White. Cut out a duplicate of the Snowman design and place over the painted design area. Spatter Brite White off an old toothbrush.

Apply “FREE” to firing form. Place glass over form **color side up!**

Fire to 1500F (cone 016). Wait until kiln is cool (cold is even better!) before opening.
